Meredith Marlowe: The bride's rebellious, pot-smoking younger sister who is very sarcastic and much annoyed with the whole fiasco downstairs. Sporting an outwardly tough attitude, she has a lot of insecurity to hide. Bridesmaid. *(Early/Mid-20s) The role involves changing onstage and brief nudity aimed offstage, and you should be willing to work with the director to achieve the artistic view.*

Georgeanne Darby: Tracy's "ugly sidekick" in high school and college. Has accepted the invitation to be a bridesmaid even though her relationship with Tracy is strained because Tracy's boyfriend had once got her pregnant. Bridesmaid. *(Late-20s/Early-30s)*

Trisha: One of Tracy's former friends with a supposed bad reputation; a jaded beauty. Bridesmaid. *(Late-20s/Early-30s) Must be comfortable with kissing onstage.*

Frances: The very naive and religious cousin of the bride. Bridesmaid. *(Early-20s)*

Mindy McClure: The groom's clumsy, outspoken lesbian older sister; She's constantly eating but has one heck of a metabolism. Bridesmaid. *(Mid-30s)*

Tripp Davenport (Griffen Lyle Davenport the Third): An usher who falls for Trisha. Not overly handsome, but definitely sexy. *(Late-20s/Early-30s) Must be comfortable with kissing onstage.*
